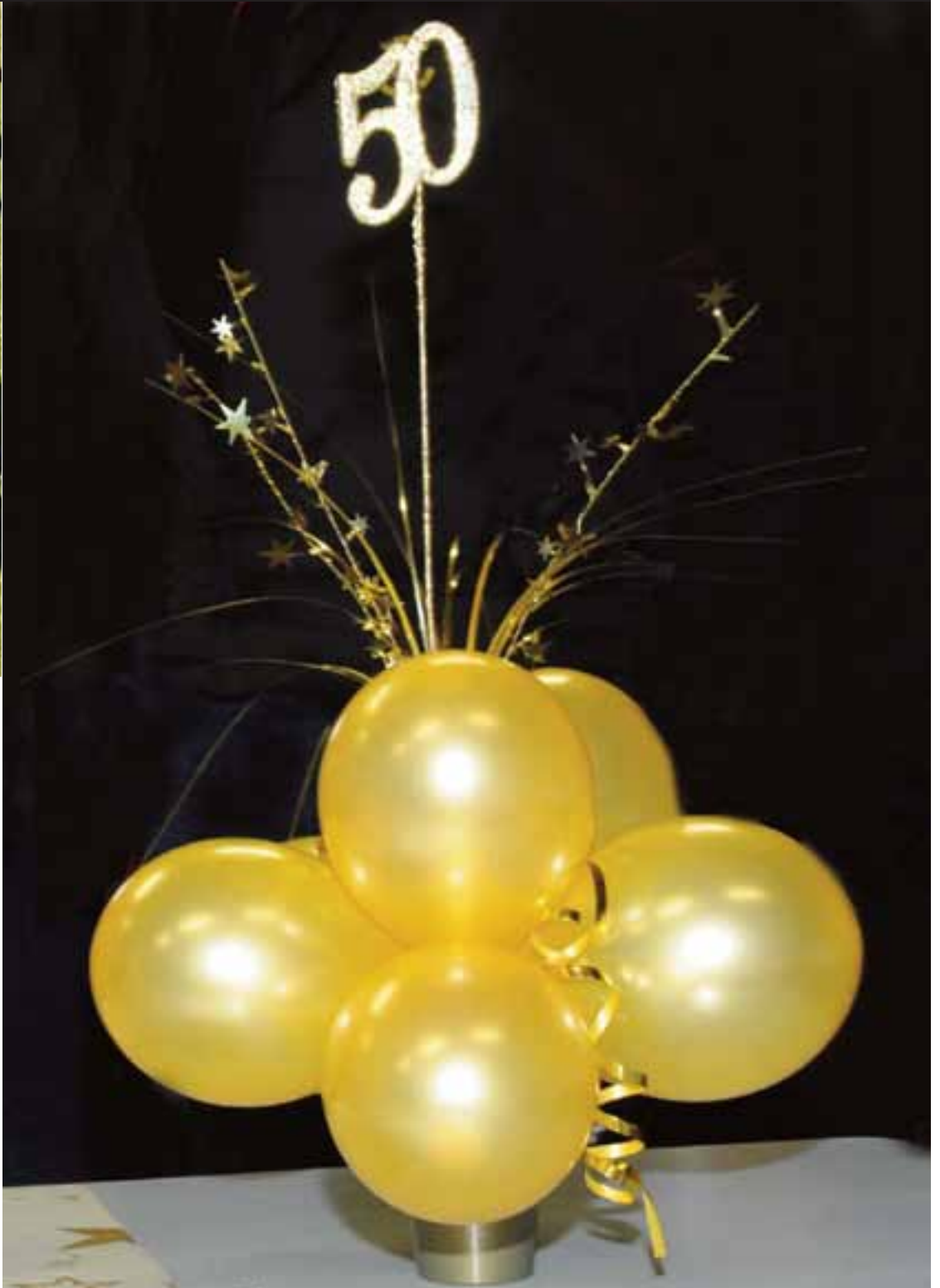
Our Annual June Obedience Trial attracted 183 entries.

The September Trial is coming up - will you have a go? Talk to your instructor and get trialling.

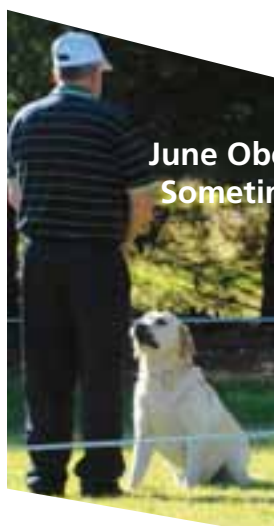

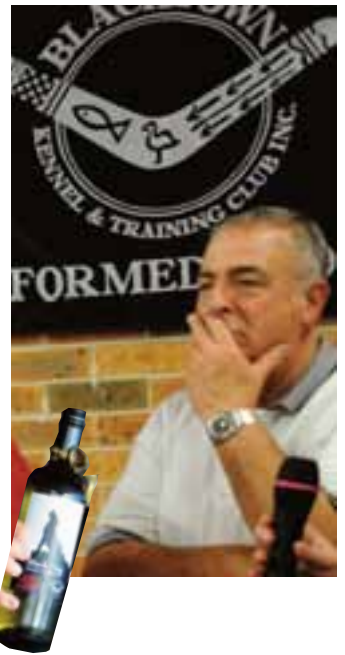

## CADY THE FIERY!

On our way home from the office a few weeks ago we were discussing the story in the online news that day about the Lab that had alerted the residents of a hotel to a fire. Little did we know that within 12 hours we would have our own story to tell.

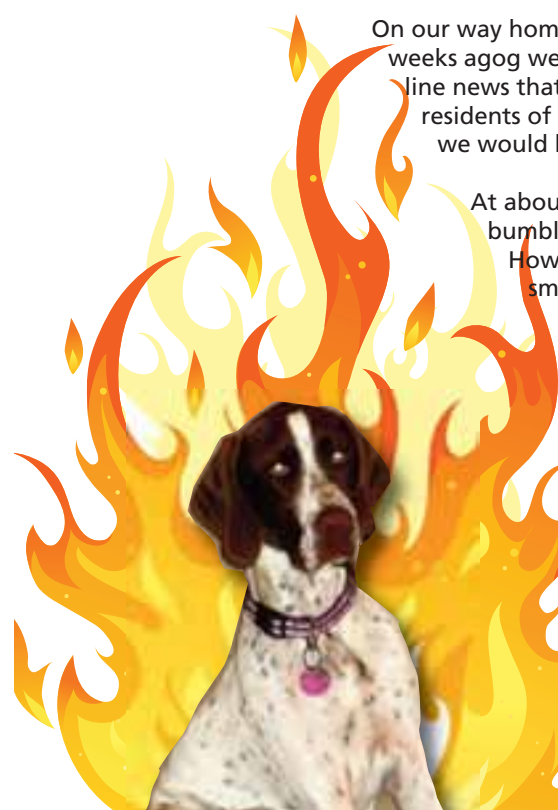
At about 5:20am the next morning I was awoken by our Pointer, Cady, barking and bumbling around the bedroom. Three quarters asleep I chased her back to her bed. However she persisted. On the third occasion my partner Karen stirred, and immediately smelt smoke.

Jumping out of bed we found that a power distribution board under our bed had caught fire and we were alight. With flames, over 100mm high coming out of the top of the board it was only minutes and the bedding would have become involved with the obvious possible threat to both of us. The real point here is that none of the high tech hardwired smoke detectors went off, even when the bedroom door was opened and smoke and fumes billowed out over the detector directly outside the door.

I do not believe that it is an exaggeration to say that Cady Dog saved, if not our lives, then saved us from almost certain serious injury. We have always adored our special girl and all her idiosyncrasies but we never thought that we would have owed her such a debt of gratitude.

I guess the bottom line is one neurotic, obsessive Pointer makes a much more reliable and cuddly lifesaver than the high tech smoke detectors.

# HEEL WORK WHEN YOU ARE TRIALLING

consistency ... consistency ... consistency ... consistency



## Heel Work

Competition heel work relies on consistent foot work to display the desired gentleness and smoothness of teamwork between handler and dog. The handler relies on the dog sitting smartly at each halt. The dog relies on the handler for consistent pace, direction and cue to perform quickly and accurately.

## Sit

1 To teach correct automatic sit - the signal to sit must be given before legs are parallel.

2 Handler should always bring right foot smartly up to left foot. This ensures a very fast response.

The dog becomes quickly conditioned and the automatic sit develops straight and fast.

## Forward

Dogs learn very quickly if a signal (left hand forward) is coupled with the command HEEL followed with the additional signal left foot (closest to dog) forward. This gives us 3 clues to ensure the dog will rise smartly from the sit position and move shoulder parallel with the handler's left leg. With correct reinforcement and conditioning, a smart rise and move forward is learnt quickly by the dog and becomes established behaviour.

## Stay

In contrast to come with me forward HEEL - stay must be clearly different.

The right hand moves directly towards the dog in a blocking motion as the right foot moves forward first.

This is clearly different from heel with me. Dogs quickly understand, allowing positive reinforcement.

## Down

The command to down or drop is given as left leg of handler touches down - the right above the dog's head in a downward motion (fingers tight).

Signal and command are given simultaneously then right leg completes the halt.

## Stand

The clearest signal for a dog to understand is a left hand black coupled with the word STAND performed as the handler's left leg is moving forward. Positive reinforcement as the right foot completes the halt ensures that the dog will learn that stand is different to sit.

## HEALTH MATTERS

A few weeks ago, the doting owner of two young lab mixes purchased Cocoa Mulch from Target to use in their garden. The dogs loved the way it smelled and it was advertised to keep cats away from their garden. Their dog, Calypso decided the mulch smelled good enough to eat and devoured a large helping.

She vomited a few times which was typical when she eats something new but wasn't acting lethargic in any way. The next day, Mum woke up and took Calypso out for her morning walk. Halfway through the walk, she had a seizure and died instantly.

Although the mulch had NO warnings printed on the label, upon further investigation on the company's web site, **"This product is HIGHLY TOXIC to dogs and cats."**

Cocoa Mulch is manufactured by Hershey's, and they claim that "It is true that studies have shown that 50% of the dogs that eat Cocoa Mulch can suffer physical harm to a variety of degrees (depending on each individual dog). However, 98% of all dogs won't eat it."

Snopes.com gives the following information: (<http://www.snopes.com/critters/crusader/cocoamulch>)

"Cocoa Mulch contains a lethal ingredient called 'Theobromine'. It is lethal to dogs and cats. It smells like chocolate and it really attracts dogs. They will ingest this stuff and die. Several deaths already occurred in the last 2-3 weeks.

Theobromine is in all chocolate, especially dark or baker's chocolate which is toxic to dogs. Cocoa bean shells contain potentially toxic quantities of theobromine, a xanthine compound similar in effects to caffeine and theophylline.

A dog that ingested a lethal quantity of garden mulch made from cocoa bean shells developed severe convulsions and died 17 hours later. Analysis of the stomach contents and the ingested cacao bean shells revealed the presence of lethal amounts of theobromine.

Never let your dog eat mulch of any kind as you cannot be sure of what chemicals are in it that are lethal to dogs.

Also, never give your dog chocolate. Some dogs may be fine in small quantities, but many are not and the chemical, Theobromine, in the chocolate can kill.



## Tuesday night training Ground Rules

- ✓ Please ensure you have a suitable collar and lead for your dog when attending training. There have been some incidents of dogs slipping their collars or simply snapping their leads. If you have any questions talk to your Instructor. They are there to help you.
- ✓ Dogs **MUST** be kept on a lead at **ALL TIMES** unless your Instructor instructs otherwise. This is for your safety, as well as others.
- ✓ Please clean up after your dog. Keep one or two doggy bags in your pocket just in case. Doggy bags can be obtained at the canteen.
- ✓ Keep the equipment clean - make sure your dog does not urinate on the witches hats used for class assembly at training.
- ✓ Bitches in Season are **NOT** allowed on the grounds. Please leave the girls at home for the duration of the season as it upsets the male dogs.

A Canteen service is available on Tuesday nights at training. We offer everything from a hot cuppa to chips, lollies and drinks.

Each year the Club has a point score and achievement award open to all obedience dogs who have competed in trials. If you qualify in accordance with the scores listed below, please send results to:

**THE TRIAL SECRETARY, Jan Probert: 16 Sylvia Street, Blacktown NSW 2148**

All results MUST be received by 31st October. Entry forms are on the opposite page.

To qualify, all passes must be obtained between 1st November of the preceding year up to 31st October of the current year.

**ALSO: THE CLUB AWARDS A TROPHY\* FOR ANY TITLE GAINED DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR FOR BREED AND OBEDIENCE. THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN AT OUR CHRISTMAS PARTY.**

**IMPORTANT\*** In order to be eligible for a Club Trophy for Breed and Obedience titles, you must attend training classes at least 50% of the year or attempt to assist the Club in other ways, ie stewarding. Those who don't meet these requirements will only be awarded a trophy at the discretion of the Committee.
